UNDER BLAZERS

The only item of clothing that is allowed to be worn under your school blazer is a grey Breda school jumper or Breda black zip top (Hoodies, sweatshirts and track-suit tops are not permitted).

OVER BLAZERS

Students may wear a dark outdoor coat to and from school. Outdoor coats can be worn over blazers outside at break and lunch and must be taken off when entering the school building and/or inside.

SCHOOL FOOTWEAR

Only fully black school footwear must be worn.

ACCEPTABLE FOOTWEAR



UNACCEPTABLE FOOTWEAR:

- X Coloured soles
- X Coloured markings/stitching
- X Coloured logos
- X Coloured laces
- X Heels



SCHOOL SCARF

The Breda school scarf is the only scarf that is allowed to be worn.

SCHOOL BAG

Students must bring an appropriate school bag each day containing stationery, resources and student planner.

JEWELLERY

Students may wear the following items: one watch, one small ring, one pair of small earrings in the lower lobes, one small stud or delicate ring in the nose. No other facial piercings are permitted.

NAILS

For reasons promoting the Health and Safety of all, students are not permitted to have long or pointed nails.

MAKE-UP

Should be discreet and kept to a minimum.

HAIR

No extremes of colour and/or style are permitted.

DRINKS

Pupils are only permitted to bring bottles of water to school. Other healthy drinks can be purchased in the school canteen.

PE KIT

The compulsory elements of the PE kit are the branded Kukri kit in the school colours with a blue main colour and purple accent colour:

Boys:

- Shorts
- Top
- Socks

Girls:

- Skort and/or black leggings
- Top
- Socks



Footwear for PE should be trainers with light or non-marking soles and laces must be tied.

All jewellery must be removed before PE lessons.

Optional items may be worn for PE, these include:

- Hooded Sweatshirt
- Smock top
