WEEK BEGINNING MON 30TH MAY: YEAR 11 ARRANGEMENTS

Due to the large number of external public exams for Year 11 students there will be no Yr 11 internal summer exam period, instead teachers will use assessments from throughout the year to award a June Report Grade and Comment. - External exams continue in June- Year 11 students are to follow the personalised exam timetable previously given to them. Replacement exam timetables are available from the Principal's secretary.
