JUNIOR SCHOOL SUMMER EXAMS 2022 (YEARS 8, 9 and 10)

Week beginning Mon 30th May

I am writing to let you know about the arrangements for the week beginning Mon 30th May. Our Junior School Summer Exams will take place from **Monday 30th May to Wednesday 1st June**. Normal lessons will be suspended and students in Years 8-10 will follow an exam timetable, supervised by staff in exam rooms. Attached to this letter is the Summer Exam timetable for your child's Year Group. There are 3 days of exams on Mon 30th, Tues 31st May and Wed 1st June with students off school on Thurs 2nd and Fri 3rd June due to the two Bank Holidays. Students are also not required in school on Mon 6th June as it is a School Development Day for staff. Please do discuss your child's exam preparation and revision with them and ensure they attend school promptly for their exams each day.
