Dear Parent/Carer

As we head towards February and the lighter days I would like to take the opportunity to draw to your attention a few important matters.

Mobile Phones

The school rules regarding students' use of mobile phones are very clear. Mobile phones must be kept out of sight and out of use in school, especially in class where the focus is naturally on learning. In particular, the recording of images, sound or video on mobile phones in school is prohibited as part of our safeguarding policy.

A teacher, on first noticing a mobile phone in use, may give a student a warning but phones can be confiscated until the end of the lesson or the end of the day, if warnings and rules are not adhered to.

I know that mobile devices can be a huge distraction and temptation. However, school should be a place where students develop their skills of learning, speaking, listening - the old fashioned face to face social interaction, rather than being focussed on a smartphone screen. We appreciate your support in ensuring your children have that positive growing up experience that so many of us enjoyed in a pre-smart-phone age.
