Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope your child's recent report is positive and that you are pleased with the progress that they are making in their learning. I would appreciate that you discuss with your child their progress and effort, praise their successes, and address any concerns that have been raised by their teacher/s. It is important that students know that we work in partnership to ensure they achieve highly in their subjects and/or qualification courses.

So that you can plan ahead, I would like to confirm our return to school dates for students in each year group as follows;

- Tuesday 30th August: Year 8 students from 9.00am to 12.00pm for their team building event and photograph. Year 13 students from 9.30am to 12.30pm for their school induction programme and photograph.
- Wednesday 31st August: Year 8 students from 9.00am to 12.30pm for their 'We are Vertigo' event. Year 14 students from 9.30am to 12.00pm for their school induction programme.
- Thursday 1st September: Years 8, 12, 13 and 14 students from 8.40am to 2.25pm (Normal school day timetable, canteen services and school bus services).
- Friday 2nd September: Years 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 from 8.40am to 3.00pm (Normal school day timetable, canteen services and school bus services).

It is important that when students return to school that they quickly adjust and follow the school's routines and expectations. This will ensure that they are organised, well presented and prepared to learn. Please ensure that your child follows our School Uniform Policy, which I attach with this letter. I would especially like to draw your attention to the requirement that students must wear fully black school shoes as described and shown on the attached School Uniform Policy and bring an appropriate school bag each day.

I am very proud to be continuing as your Acting Principal again next year and I wish you and your family an enjoyable and safe summer break.
