## **Junior School Winter Exams and Study Week 2022**

I am writing to let you know about the arrangements for our Junior School Winter Exams and Study Week 2022, which will take place from **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> November to Thursday 1st December**. Normal lessons will be suspended and students will follow an exam timetable, supervised by staff in exam rooms. Attached to this letter is the Junior School Winter Exam timetable. Fri 2 <sup>nd</sup> Dec	'Catch-up' Day	Students <b>are not</b> required in school.  However, if your child misses any exam during the week, they will be expected to attend on Friday to complete their exams. The school office will contact you in this case.

During each Junior School Exam Day, students must:

- Wear school uniform
- Bring appropriate equipment
- Bring revision materials

These internal exams are extremely important and will show teachers, students, and parents/carers the progress students are making in their subjects. I wish all students the very best of success in their exams.
